This guide is designed to assist in programming a T38G IP telephones to work with an IPitomy IP PBX System. The phones has many advanced features. This guide is designed to get the basic features enabled to integrate with the most popular features used with the IPitomy System.

## Connecting the telephone

Connect the RJ45 plug on the back of the phone marked "Internet" to the LAN

A PC can be attached to the other RJ45 jack marked "PC"


Once the unit is connected to the LAN, check the network status using the soft keys to select Status

Now write down the IP address and use it to browse to the web interface of the T38G.














## **Programming Steps**


- 2. Select Account 1

- 11. Select Confirm

- 3. Select Time Format
- 4. Set Backlight and Display Options

The T38G has 4 key programming Options


Memory keys Memory Keys are the programmable buttons on the right side

- 5. Affix IPitomy Logo (Optional)




## Memory Keys



- 1. Park Key
- 2. BLF or Speed Dial for your application
- 3. Pause Key ABC<Extension Number>
- 4. Select Confirm

Programmable Keys - Soft keys. IPitomy recommends removing DND and replacing it with Pause.
